6) Principal Report: New COVID mask guideline are that everyone has to where a mask at all times except students who can not tolerate them, whether for health or behaviour reasons, or those who can not put on a mask without assistance, temporarily for ID purposes, temporarily for educational activities that can't be performed while wearing it (wind instruments, physical activity, etc.), eating/drinking, or if they are behind a barrier, service to disability that requires lip reading or facial cues. All prom and Grad events are on hold for now, they are looking into options. Course selection is complete and they are now working on staffing and timetabling for next year. Enrollment is projected to go up considerably (from 292 this year to 317 next year approximately). Report Cards will go out digitally to parents on April 29th. April 30th There will be a celebration for Rick Dugdales induction into AL Fortunes hall of fame, the Drumline will be playing and an film that Rick had made while in Highschool will also be shown. The water station is installed, an invoice will be sent to the PAC and pictures will be sent to share on Facebook.
